- Little Pantry – Really being used. Chris has been receiving donations and it's getting used regularly.
- Severe Weather Shelter – 5 days in February & 1 day in March activated. Looking ahead at the weather, the season may be over. Lots of volunteers did get trained to administer the rapid COVID testing. Stan asked about a way to recognize SWS volunteers; once the season is for sure over, Kathy will be working to put together recognition.
- Community Conversation – 3rd and final conversation will take place tomorrow.
- Grants – Stacy will be sending a PGST Food Bank Community Meal donation in the amount of \$2500 soon and will also be applying for the upcoming Appendix X grant round for Kingston Cares in the amount of \$2500.
